Akula Advisory School Board Discipline Matrix Adopted FY18

Education thrives when parents, students, teachers, administration, and the community work together toward common goals. Discipline is an integral component of education that works best when everyone involved knows exactly what to expect.

All schools within the Lower Kuskokwim School District follow the District Wide Discipline Guide. Individual schools shall adopt site discipline plans with input from students, staff and community members, which meet the district discipline guidelines.

It is important to note that for every right there is a matching responsibility. For example, one student right is, "A free and appropriate public school education." The matching responsibility is to, "Know and follow all school rules and procedures."

The following Discipline Matrix was developed by the elected Advisory School Board of Akula Elitnaurvik during the 2017-18 school year and is in alignment with the Lower Kuskokwim School District Discipline Guidelines.

It is understood that Administrators may use discretion in applying consequences due to individual circumstances.

For the purpose of discipline at Akula Elitnaurvik, it is acceptable for parents to attend classes with their student in lieu of suspensions when appropriate.

The following terms are clarified as follows:

- <u>Teacher-Student Conference:</u> The teacher discusses the situation with the student and then work with the student to develop positive behavior. During this step, teachers and students correct and prevent many problems.
- <u>Teacher-Student-Parent-Resource Person-Admin Conference:</u> Everyone involved works together to develop a solution to the problem. The conference often results in a behavior agreement, which outlines specific rewards and consequences designed to change the student's behavior.
- <u>In-School-Suspension:</u> The student remains in school but does not attend classes. Counselor or other resource person provides student with conduct guidelines and course studies. All privileges/Extra-Curricular Activities are suspended.
- <u>Out-of-School-Suspension:</u> The student remains out of school for a short-term, from a fraction of one day to ten school days duration. The student is not allowed to participate in school activities or be on school campus.
- <u>Long-Term-Suspension/Expulsion:</u> The student will be removed from school for 11 days or more to a maximum of one school year. This requires Superintendent approval and a formal due process hearing including written notification of charges.
- <u>Disciplinary Reassignment:</u> The student may be transferred to another room or alternative location or school for a specified period of time. Subject to review by a school or district multi-disciplinary team or superintendent/designee.
- <u>Alternative School Placement:</u> Alternative schools address the educational needs of student who are re-enrolling in school and those referred by a multi-disciplinary team or Superintendent/designee due to severe disruptive behavior. They use low teacher-student ratios, comprehensive support services, behavioral interventions, and a specialized curriculum, as well as career training and employment opportunities.
